- In any situation Ayeyarwady foundation will not make a donation or financial contributions if doing so could be or appear to be an act of corruption, in violation of Anti-corruption Policy.

MONITORING AND REPORTING

To the end, we are committed to monitoring our contributions under this policy, and to updating the policy on an annual basis.
